Priorities will be given to those majoring in Family & Consumer Sciences or related programs, Agriculture or Related Programs (see attached sheet) and your 4-H participation and involvement.

The following are guidelines for the scholarship:

1. The recipient must live in Owsley County or attend Owsley County Schools.
2. They must be a 2014 high school graduate or equivalent.
3. They must be enrolled in or accepted by an accredited college or university.
4. They must submit a letter requesting the scholarship, a transcript of their high school grades and a brief essay. This essay must include a biographical sketch of community & club involvement concluding with a paragraph of your future plans.
5. Also, include your name, address, telephone and other contact information on your essay.
6. The scholarship will be awarded by the Owsley County Extension Homemaker Scholarship Committee based on the items above.
7. The Owsley County Extension Homemaker Scholarship Committee's decision will be final.
